The Local Authority will notify parents of primary school allocations for admission to Year 3 in September 2017 on 18 April 2017.

If your child is not allocated a place, you are entitled to appeal.

If you wish to make an appeal, you must submit an online appeal form no later than 5pm on Wednesday 17 May 2017. Appeals forms can be found at:

Appeals will be held within 40 school days from 17 May 2017, that is, no later than Wednesday 19 July 2017.

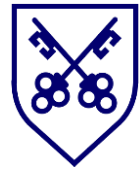

Oversubscription Admission Criteria

Places will be allocated to students who have a statement of special education needs names the school as appropriate provision. Where there are more applications for places than there are places available, priority will be given in the following order:

1. Children in public care (looked after children) or previously in public care
2. Children residing in the linked area.
3. Children with siblings attending the school at the time of application with a reasonable expectation they will be attending at the start of the new academic year.
4. Children attending linked infant school.
5. Children who live closer to the preferred school than any other school.
6. Other children who live outside the designated priority admission area.

If the admission number is exceeded within criterion (2) or (5), priority will be given to those who live the furthest from the nearest alternative school. If the admission number is exceeded with any other criterion priority will be given to those who live the closest to the school.

In-Year Applications

Parents who wish to apply to changes their child's school during the school year need to complete an In-Year Application form available at:

Students moving to the area

If a child is moving to the area and requires a school place, parents will also need to apply for an in-year school place through School Admissions at Northamptonshire County Council. The admissions team will require a confirmed address and a moving date.

Where School Admissions are unable to allocate a place at the parents preferred school, there is an option to be added to the schools waiting list.
