Star of the Term


Teachers will be selecting their Star of the Term at Home this week as well as a Star of the Term per bubble group in school. The winners will be announced during the live catch up sessions per class.

We have contacted some local bookshops to see if we can bulk order these £1 books on behalf of our families. We will update you once we have any further information.



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
