Dear parents and carers

In a further update to our transition arrangements, we wish to confirm that Year 6 students will be taking part in an exciting three days of transition between the Wednesday 06 July and Friday 08 July, here at Manor School. This also includes an invitation for parents and carers to our 'meet the tutor' event which will take place during our final student transition day, on Friday 8 July. The event will involve a presentation from the Head of School and the Progress Leader responsible for transition, Mr Isaacs, followed by an opportunity to meet your child's form tutor, and ask any questions.

Manor School ambassadors will also provide an opportunity for parents and carers to take a tour of key areas of the school.

Karl Sports, our uniform supplier, will be present on the evening and will provide an opportunity for students to try on uniform along with the option to order.

We will be running three consecutive sessions so that we are able to ensure we coordinate capacity in the main hall when parents meet the tutors. Families will be allocated a time slot in which to attend. Year 6 students will remain in school, so they are able to attend with parents, following the conclusion of their transition days

Full details and timings of the 3 transition days, together with your time slot for the parents and carers event will be sent to you over the coming weeks.

We would also like to provide you with initial information regarding our leadership academy for 2022-23. There will be several spaces available to our new Year 7 students and there will be several opportunities to lead in various school events throughout the year. Students will be able to apply via a letter of application. Further details will be provided over time.
