Michael Rosen is an inspirational, funny and very famous author and poet.


Check out his youtube videos to watch him perform his own poems—they are very entertaining!

### ANIMAL OF THE TERM— THE NORTHERN WHITE RHINO

Sadly, you will never see a male Northern White Rhino anywhere in the world anymore.

Unfortunately Sudan, the last one in existence, died recently in Kenya. All the animal conservation agencies from every country have not been able to save this magnificent species from extinction.

Years of poaching for their horns for use in Chinese medicine caused their numbers to fall to about 30 left in Central Africa by the 1980s. Since then, war has wiped out the last few remaining in the wild leaving Sudan and two female companions living in a protected park in Kenya. They have been guarded by armed conservation workers around the clock since arrival to stop them meeting the same fate as the rest of their species. Alas, old age claimed Sudan in March 2018, meaning that the females will never be able to breed and the species is now considered officially extinct.


